This letter is to confirm the reservation I made with Doug Lee of your department reserving the western end of the Polo Grounds for the morning of Saturday, April 12, 1980 from 8:00 a.m. till 12:00 Noon.

We will be holding the opening ceremonies for HikaNation there starting at 10:00 a.m. We will be collecting a \$ 3.00 registration fee for cover our expenses relating to this event. We expect about 10,000 people to attend the opening day activities at the Polo Grounds.

We are working with Peter Nardoza of Mayor Feinstein's office to coordinate our requirements for police services. The Boy Scouts of America will be working with us to provide monitors, security, paramedic services, and clean-up support.

Dear Mr. Gee:

Your letter, dated March 27, 1980, addressed to Mr. Leonard Fitzpatrick, Assistant Superintendent of Recreation, has been referred to me for reply.

At your request, we have reserved the west end of the Polo Field in Golden Gate Park as a staging area for the HikaNation's Walk-A-Thon scheduled for Saturday, April 12, 1980, from 8:00 a.m. until 12 noon.

Per the terms of our telephone conversation on Wednesday, April 2, 1980, we agreed on the following stipulations:

1. The American Hiking Society will provide a debris box for excess debris.
2. Monitors will assist at checkpoints.
3. Paramedic services will provide First-Aid.
4. There will be no amplification of sound. 10 watt bullhorns will be used.
5. The American Hiking Society will provide a \$250 performance bond to insure clean-up of the area. The bond must be in the form of a cashier's check and deposited with the Commission Secretary at least three days prior to the event. It will be refunded if the reserved area is left clean.

This permit will become valid upon receipt of the \$1,000,000.00 insurance policy insuring the City and County of San Francisco and the Recreation and Park Commission.


