ACR 109, as amended, Agnos (Trans.). San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge: temporary closure.

This measure would request the Department of Transportation to ~~temporarily close~~ *authorize the closure of necessary lanes of* the upper level of the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge on Sunday, April 13, 1980, for a walk across the bridge as part of the American Hiking Society's **HikaNation**, a transcontinental hike, and on Sunday, June 1, 1980, for a bicycle ride across the bridge as part of the Bay Area Bicycle Action Day.

1 WHEREAS, There is an obligation to call the public's
2 attention to low energy forms of recreation and
3 transportation; and

4 WHEREAS, Plans have been made for a
5 transcontinental hike, HikaNation, sponsored by the
6 American Hiking Society, to include a walk across the
7 upper level of the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge in
8 the morning hours of Sunday, April 13, 1980; and

9 WHEREAS, Plans have been made for a Bay Area
10 Bicycle Action Day, sponsored by the Bay Area Bicycle
11 Action Council, to include a bicycle ride over the upper
12 level of the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge in the
13 morning hours of Sunday, June 1, 1980; and

14 WHEREAS, Both these functions are charitable and
15 are supported by various civic, environmental, and youth
16 organizations and leaders; now, therefore, be it

17 *Resolved by the Assembly of the State of California, the*
18 *Senate thereof concurring,* That the Department of
19 Transportation is hereby requested to authorize the
20 closure of necessary lanes of the upper level of the San
21 Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge on Sunday, April 13, 1980,
22 for the period of time necessary to permit its use as part
23 of the course of the HikaNation, a transcontinental hike;
24 and be it further

25 *Resolved,* That the department is hereby requested to
26 authorize the closure of necessary lanes of the upper level
27 of the bay bridge on Sunday, June 1, 1980, for the period
28 of time necessary to permit its use as part of the course
29 of the Bay Area Bicycle Action Day bicycle ride; and be
30 it further

31 *RESOLVED,* That the department is hereby requested
32 to report to the Legislature not later than October 1, 1980,
33 on the impact of this and other similar bridge closures;
34 and be it further

35 *Resolved,* That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly
36 transmit a copy of this resolution to the Director of
37 Transportation.
