This measure would request the Department of Transportation to authorize the closure of necessary lanes of the upper level of the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge on Sunday, April 13, 1980, for a walk across the bridge as part of the American Hiking Society's **HikaNation**, a transcontinental hike, and on Sunday, June 1, 1980, for a bicycle ride across the bridge as part of the Bay Area Bicycle Action Day.
