

MONTY'S NOTES

1. Min. 25 and max. 30 hikers for each hike segment
2. Time duration of each hike 21 days
3. Total hike distance (a variable) - 160+ miles
4. Registration fee for each hiker/per hike - \$75 (maybe higher)
5. Monthly location of the hike:

March - California	July - Colorado
April - Nevada	Aug. - Oklahoma/ Arkansas
May - Utah	Sept. - Arkansas / Missouri
June - Colorado	Oct. - Missouri / Illinois

6. General geographical location of each hike (to be refined)

California - Pony Express Trail  
Nevada - Tonopah to Panaca  
Utah - Bryce Canyon to Monticello  
Colorado - Delores to Creed(#1) -- Silverton to Pagosa Springs (#2)  
Oklahoma - Claremore to Fort Gickson(?)  
Arkansas - Winslow to Pindall  
Missouri - Alton to Fredericktown  
Illinois - River to river

7. Hike's general schedule:

1 day orientation  
5 days hiking at average 8 mpd  
1 rest day  
6 days hiking at average 10 mpd  
2 rest days  
5 days hiking at average 12 mpd  
1 day for disbandment

8. Management "on trail" cost for each hike - \$1870

Leadership/pathfinder wagon @ \$25/wk. x 3 x 2 persons	- \$150
Support vehicle fuel costs	- 425
175 m x 10 (ratio of vehicle travel to hiker)	
mileage = 1750 veh miles	
1750 ÷ 5 (mpg) = 350 gals. 350 x \$1.50 =	\$425
Food allowance for leadership	
21 days x \$5 x 2 persons	- 210
Vehicle and leadership ins. (monthly est.)	
30 days x \$5	- 150

Monty's Notes (con't.)

Miscellaneous expenses (medical supplies, postal materials,  
adm., telephone, etc.)  
30 hikers x \$2 = \$60

Vehicle mileage cost  
1750 miles x \$.50/m = 875

9. Managements break-even point for each hike  
(# hikers x \$75) = 255  
(# hikers x 100) = 19
